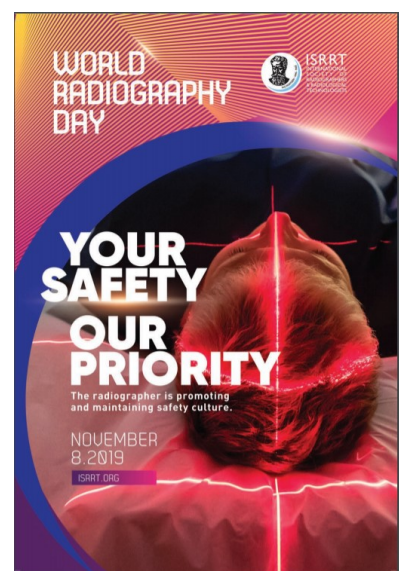
## Executive Committee 2019-2021
