MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN

Dear members,

We have our ASM/AGM successfully held on 18 August with ~ 90 registrants and around 60 of them joined our annual dinner.

For AGM this year we have focus on constitution amendments that clearly define the criteria for membership. We also change the amount of annual fee from a fixed amount of HK\$150 to a range of zero up to HK\$500, which will give more flexibility.

For Professional Indemnity Insurance, as some members reflect that HA already had a certain coverage, we ask the Insurer to give us more options by giving us another plan which may reduce the duplication of coverage.

We will celebrate our World Radiography Day (WRD) together with the PolyU students this year. Student Ambassador of Radiography (SAR) is a student organization that arranges all the ac-

tivities and we will again promote the understanding of radiography to Public through these activities. A poster of RD designed by ISRRT and some labels will be distributed to the radiographers.

A football team formed with members had joined the football competition organized by HKPU in this summer. The team had beat 5 other teams and won championship in the event. Let's show our congratulations to them once more.




ECOTOUR (6 MAY)
